John L. Larson Reports New TD37 Discovery

Fellow dummy stamp collector John L. Larson has reported a previously unlisted variety of Scott TD37, a red Multipost test coil with full shading lines.

The new TD37 discovery has gauge 11.5 vertical perforations, while the previously known TD37 issue measures 9.75. This significant difference normally creates a major catalog number. The new discovery has been reported to Scott Publishing Company for inclusion in the 2013 Scott Specialized Catalogue.

Please check your TD37 dummy stamps, and report any with 11.5 perfs.

The discovery was recently sold for \$150.00. This sale could help establish a Scott catalog value.

The discovery pair is shown nearby and has a hinge remnant on the left stamp while the right stamp is never hinged. \Box

Michael O. Perry Reports New Dummy Booklet

Fellow Dummy Stamp Study Group member, Michael O. Perry recently brought to my attention a previously unreported dummy stamp booklet.

The previously unreported dummy booklet was Lot 452 in the December 7, 2011 Sam Houston Philatelics Mail Sale 3002. The lot was described as follows: "Lot 452 TDB26, "G" stamp Test Bklt/2, 10stamp blank panes of TDP11, VF NH, small ink line mark on cover only Cat(\$160)". (see illustration on page 4)

The current 2012 Scott Specialized Catalogue value for TDB26 is listed at \$160.00. TDB26 has blank (unprinted) inside and outside covers. The lot was illustrated showing only the inside of the booklet with the copyright notice on the inside cover and the blank panes.

That illustration showing the "K" under the copyright notice is what indicated to Mike this was a previously unreported dummy booklet. The "1992" copyright date with a "K" under it was only found on the 29-cent Flag and G Rate booklets made by KCS.

TDB26 was produced by the Bureau of Engraving and Printing. There is an American Bank Note Company dummy "G" Rate booklet listed with 2 blank panes but both panes are panes of 5. This dummy booklet is listed in the 2012 Scott Specialized Catalogue as TDB38.

As shown in the "Recent Auctions of Interest" section of this newsletter the previously unreported dummy booklet in the Sam Houston auction must have gathered quite a bit of interest as the bidding started at \$18.00 and the final hammer price was \$500.00 + 15%buyer's premium when it was all over! Whoever the buyer was now has a previously unreported dummy booklet variety.







Proposed Future DSSG Projects

Updating Research Paper Number 3 - Dummy Stamp Booklets

Work is progressing, very much still at a snail's pace, on updating Research Paper Number 3 - Dummy Stamp Booklets. The last update by Earl McAfee, Dummy Booklets Study Group Chairman, was in 1998. Since then there have been many new discoveries. Many of them have been written up in articles in The United States Specialist. Now the time has come to document and illustrate them in a new updated version of Research Paper Number 3. I am in charge of this update project and knowing that it will take quite

a bit of time to complete, have no estimated completion date in mind. I will be asking all of you to join me in this project as I am not able to do it all, nor would you want me to do it all. It is a DSSG project and all members should have a chance to provide their input. Several illustrations are needed and a listing of these will be sent to you when I compile it. Scans at 300 dpi are necessary for clarity. It is anticipated that this publication will be in color. It has not yet been determined if it will be available on CD.

The Other Projects

There are several other projects currently being worked on by various members of the DSSG. They are as follows:

- Compiling a complete and comprehensive list of dummy test stamp roll sizes, box and roll labels. There are many different styles of labels sometimes found on the same test stamps. This is especially true of Bureau of Engraving and Printing products
- Compiling a complete and comprehensive record of auction appearances and prices realized for test stamps
- Compiling a complete and comprehensive listing of references for test stamps
- Compiling a complete and comprehensive list
 of plate numbers printed on test stamps and the
 frequency in which they appear and the frequency of joint lines on test coils when they
 appear.
