As reported in the last issue of *Dummy News* and Views we typically meet with Mr. James. Kloetzel, Editor Emeritus of the Scott Catalogues, at the annual WESTPEX Stamp Show in San Francisco that is usually held the last week of April.

WESTPEX was cancelled in 2020, and in 2021 it was rescheduled for July 30 - August 1. Because of this change, Jim was unable to attend the show since he was in the final stages of completing changes to the various Scott Catalogues that he is assigned to work on.

Because we were unable to meet with Jim at WESTPEX, both Mike Perry and I worked with Jim online to finalize our suggestions for the 2022 *Scott Specialized*. While it was not as satisfying as meeting with Jim as usual, we did manage to get things changed and added that we hoped to achieve.

We will mention a few of these changes (but not all of them, and not all the details). We strongly encourage you to purchase a 2022 Scott Specialized Catalogue of United States Stamps & Covers so you can see the changes in detail.

With new information found at the web site <u>www.gbstamprolls.com/affixing-vending/</u> several of the dates previously assigned to some of the test stamps listed in the Scott Specialized Catalogue were revised. Examples include TD31 to TD36A, TD37, TD38, TD53 and TD54, TD61, TD64 and TD65, TD66, TD69A and TD69B,

TD70A, TD73, TD78, TD78A, TD78B, TD91 to TD93.

TD46 had a footnote added about a paste-up strip that has double perforations between one pair. A new listing was added for TD57B, a Mail-O-Meter violet stamp with Schermack Type III perforations. A footnote was added to the TD90 listing to describe a strip of 4 with a "gap" in the stamp printing and then an "overlap" print. This strip is shown below.

TD94a and TD95a were clarified to better describe the stamp image sizes to avoid confusion between these two test stamps.

Information was added to several listing of test coils to indicate the distance between the joint lines or the plate numbers since they do vary on several issues.

Several new listings were added this year. Interestingly a new listing was added for TD123A - a self adhesive Flag Over Porch test coil that looks similar to Scott 2915A or 2915C which are normal coils. There is a lengthy description detailing this new listing. It is shown below.



Values were added for the TD130G Tropical Fish test stamp which is shown below.



A new TD136A For Testing Purposes Only coil with a vertical line between the "N" and "L" of "ONLY" but without the light blue masking ink since this test stamp was printed on paper that was not pre-phosphored. It is shown below.



A new TD141 For Testing Purposes Only coil printed for Kirk-Rudy was added. It is shown below.



In the Test Booklets section, several listings had information added to indicate that "Some panes show joint lines."

Several of the Test Booklet listings had the catalogue values revised, usually downward, to reflect current auction realizations and reduced selling princes.

A new listing for TDB49, a booklet with two For Testing Purposes Only panes, was added. The pane is illustrated below.



In the Test Stamp Essays section there were several new listings added to the previous two listings, all for the George Clinton essays. Details of each of them were added to describe the differences. See the next page for an example of a Clinton essay that was sold in June in a Cherrystone auction.
