

## Chapter 60

### The Commemoratives

It is the commemorative series of stamps that probably got most young collectors hooked into collecting stamps. There is a special appeal to an item that is available only a short while, unlike the regular issues which seem to last forever. The commemoratives seem to have it all - interesting subjects, beautiful designs, and more than their share of philatelic controversies. The commemoratives are in many ways the easiest series for the plate number collector. There are hundreds of different stamps, most with only a few plate numbers and most of the stamps are inexpensive. The average number of plates used per stamp is 8.3. While a high degree of completion is possible, there are also real challenges.

Collectors mainly collected plate strips or plate singles of the early issues and plate blocks are scarce and expensive. Matched set plate block collecting became very popular when the rotary press began producing commemoratives. The collector who wants all of the plate numbers is generally happy to have plate singles and mint plate number singles are the easiest items to locate.

The 1898 Trans-Mississippi set is a real favorite of many collectors. The real challenge for the plate number collector is the 2c stamp which was printed from 121 plates. It is much easier to find a plate number copy of the \$2 value than to locate all of the 2c plate numbers. The Trans-Mississippi set is difficult to complete but it can be done. When you complete this issue, insist that the family take you out to your favorite restaurant because you have earned it (and you are probably broke)! The 1901 Pan-American issue has fewer plates but the 1c value has some truly rare plates with center plate number 1236 being recently discovered and it is so far the only known copy. Plate number combinations can be collected in strips or blocks but this type of collecting of this issue is an extremely tough endeavor.

The 1912 Panama-Pacific issue has some plates available in both perforation 12 and perforation 10 gauge. Completing all of the Panama-Pacific plates is not super difficult unless you insist on all of the perforation varieties. Many of the early commemoratives were issued in sets and most of the plate numbers occurred on the 1c and 2c stamps. The challenge is in completing the 1c and 2c values. The higher values cost more, but, with very few plates used, these are easy to obtain. None of the plates on the 2c Louisiana Purchase, 2c Jamestown, 2c Alaska-Yukon, or 2c Panama-Pacific are rare, but locating all of them is not an easy task. Fortunately, plate singles are plentiful on the early commemoratives and success can be attained much more easily than on the regular issue stamps.

The death of President Harding in 1923 caused the quick issuance of the 2c Harding Memorial stamp. This stamp saw heavy use and 166 flat plates and eight rotary plates were used. Some of the flat plates are hard to find with the last plate (15195) being the

most difficult. One of the difficulties with completing the flat plates is the large number of plates to locate. Some of the flat plates are available imperforate. The rotary plates are difficult to find in nicely centered condition.

Two 1926 issues are of special interest. The Sesquicentennial stamp was printed from 60 plates and four of these are overprinted for use in the Canal Zone. The White Plains stamp was also issued in a small sheet of 25 and this was the first souvenir sheet. The four plates that printed the souvenir sheet are easy to find (but expensive).

The 1925 2c and 5c Norse-American stamps are bi-colors each requiring a frame plate and a center plate to produce a completed stamp and combinations can be collected in plate strips of four or plate blocks of eight. It would be an interesting, but expensive, challenge to go for all of the combinations. The 1929 2c Clark stamp has 144 combinations (288 positions). But the big items for the collector interested in plate number combinations are the 2c Red Cross and 2c Yorktown stamps of 1931. These stamps were very popular at the time of issue and widely saved which is good news for the collector over 60 years later as these plate blocks are quite reasonable in price. To give an idea of the scarcity of some of the combinations, the scarcest plate on the 2c Yorktown stamp is center plate 20602 with only 4200 impressions. This plate is combined with all 16 frame plates so if the impression distribution was even, then each combination would average only about 260 impressions! These would be super rarities if suddenly all plate number collectors wanted them!

The Washington Bicentennial set of 1932 was very popular, especially with the matched set collectors, and many collections were made of both plate blocks and plate singles. None of the plates is rare but a few are on the scarce side and completing all of the plates in all positions is a tough job. I placed a bid for a complete matched set of this issue in plate singles which appeared in an auction a few years ago and was successful in getting the lot at a very reasonable price. It almost seems unfair that I was able to obtain in just minutes what it took another collector perhaps years to build but then I think the other collector had a lot more fun in the struggle to reach his goal. It is interesting to note that booklets and coils were planned for the 2c Washington stamp but they were never issued.

1933 and 1934 saw a large number of commemorative plates which became available in both perforated and imperforate form including the attractive National Parks set. These are common items and having examples of both types makes an interesting display.

The rotary press was gradually assuming more of the commemorative production starting around 1935. This meant fewer plate numbers to chase and it helped to popularize collecting of plate blocks in matched sets. Only the National defense and Win the War issues in the early 1940s added some challenge to the collecting of commemorative plate numbers. Staring in the late 1930s, collectors had a 20 year run where almost all of the commemorative plates were very easy to find.

The introduction of the Giori press in 1957 with the 4c Flag stamp heralded big changes for commemoratives and within a short time most issues were multicolored

stamps printed from this new press. The 8c Bolivar and 8c Kossuth stamps had some scarce combinations to chase. Then came the shocking news about the discovery of plate number 26343 on the 4c St. Lawrence Seaway stamp. All impressions from this plate were reportedly destroyed at the BEP but two upper left plate blocks were found. Matched set collectors were dismayed because there was now to be a hole in their collections that probably could not be filled. I remember feeling disappointment as a young collector about not being able to own a copy of this number. But this was in my early years and I have long since decided that I do not have to own them all to have a lot of fun. The enjoyment is in the chase, and in seeing how far I can go, and the feeling of accomplishment is enhanced with each new plate number I add to my collection. And there is always the possibility that other examples of plate 26343 are sitting somewhere unrecognized and you or I may just be the one to find one of them.

The 4c Nursing stamp of 1961 was another combination issue with originally some scarce to rare plate number combinations. Collectors caused such an uproar that the post office had the BEP make special printings of the scarce and rare combinations. The next big event was the 4c Hammarskjold stamp of 1962, another combination printing, when a sheet was discovered with one printing inverted relative to the other printing. The post office quickly had the BEP intentionally print millions of the errors in all combinations. The sedate collecting times were certainly over!

A new printing technique, the combination of offset and intaglio, was begun in 1965. A decision was made to position the offset plate numbers so that they would be trimmed from the finished product which resulted in many holes in the sequence of plate numbers for the consecutive plate number collector. The average number of plates assigned that would reach collectors had been hovering around 85% but with the trimmed offset plates, the percentage dropped to around 67%. Perhaps some of the consecutive number collectors, those who collect all of the numbers, lost interest around this time because of the big increase in unavailable plate numbers.

The next big plate number event was the 9 color Huck press which made its debut with the 1968 Christmas stamp. This was the first of the large size plate blocks and that, plus the impossibility of the combination chase, may have contributed to many collectors losing interest in the collecting of commemorative plates. The 1968 and 1969 Christmas stamps were printed on this press and many of the plates are scarce to rare. The 1968 Christmas stamp has the first three unreported commemorative plate numbers.

Production of commemorative stamps by the gravure method was introduced in 1967 with the 5c Eakins stamp following by the 6c Disney stamp in 1968. The plate numbers were bunched in the margins resulting in plate blocks of four, but starting with the 1970 Christmas stamp, each plate number was placed adjacent to a stamp resulting in large plate blocks of 8, 10, or 12 stamps. Collecting of matched sets seemed to plummet and to this day has not recovered even with the introduction of the new plate numbering system in 1981. Postage rates began to climb and the number of plates used on the intaglio and intaglio-offset issues climbed so that 12 to 16 plates per issue seemed to happen more frequently, adding to the financial burden of the remaining matched set collectors. The 50 State Flags stamp was issued in 1975 and it made sense to collect

this and subsequent panes with 50 different stamps as full panes. The face value of a complete matched set of the 50 State Flags stamp is \$156.00!

Many collectors, including myself, were stunned to hear about plans for the new plate numbering system to go in effect in 1981. Most of us had thought we would never see the end of the plate number series, but it happened fast. The last five digit commemorative plate number is 39431 which printed the 15c Architecture stamp of 1980. The new plate numbering system gave something and it took something. Collectors were given plate blocks of four stamps and offset plate numbers were now placed on the finished product. Plate numbers were now placed on booklets and coils. But the real plate numbers were gone and even though the new code number represented the 'real' 5 digit numbers, many collectors felt it just wasn't the same and they stopped their collecting at the end of the 5 digit plate numbers. The new offset plates quickly presented real challenges to the combination collectors. Just try and get all of the combinations on the 18c Yorktown/Cape and 20c Desert Plants stamps of 1981! Some of the combinations are rare and the low catalog prices reflect collector apathy. There is an opportunity for the ambitious plate number collector to assemble some real rarities but it will be a tough task. The BEP saw no reason to continue the historic postage stamp plate number series in 1985 since no more stamps using the real plate numbers were being produced. The real plate numbers became part of the BEP's miscellaneous plate number series. The last commemorative plate number of the postage stamp series was 41302, a gravure cylinder with plate code number 3 assigned to the 22c Rural Electric stamp of 1985.

The commemoratives are an ideal group for the plate number collector who would like to accumulate a lot of plates cheaply and in a hurry. There are 7032 plates available, more than any other section except for the gigantic 3rd Bureau series. A 99% completion percentage is very possible with the commemoratives. The collecting possibilities in this group seem limitless. There is abundant challenge for the combination enthusiast. The matched set collector can accumulate hundreds of plates cheaply and most dealers will have a good stock. A good start would be to buy a collection from another collector, at auction, or from a dealer, since usually these can be had for a very good price and the unwanted items can be traded or used for postage. If you are already a plate number collector, you are probably already into commemoratives in some way. If you enjoy them, you can consider another variety of collecting such as matched sets or consecutive numbers or plate number combinations. The chances are that another collecting passion will emerge.

The air mail stamp plates are a real favorite of many and are the subject of the next chapter.
